

## SCA 2008-2009 Academic Year College Internship Program

The NYC School Construction Authority is recruiting local architectural, engineering (electrical, mechanical and civil) and construction management college sophomores and juniors with a B or better average (at least a 2.8 cumulative GPA) for the 2008-2009 Academic Year with the eventual goal of potential placement with the SCA upon college graduation.

Architectural and engineering interns assist architects and engineers in drafting of design projects using AutoCAD, assist in the review of shop drawings and participate in field inspections.

Intermediate knowledge of AutoCAD version 2006 is strongly preferred. Project management interns, interested in pursuing a career in construction management, are assigned to a line project and support duties including field inspections, preparation of documentation related to the management of active construction projects, tracking shop drawing submissions and approvals, researching contract plans and specifications to resolve field issues.

The Academic Year Internship runs from October 2, 2008-May 29, 2009. Interns are permitted to work up to 20 hours a week during the academic year and up to 35 hours during the summer from June 1st through August 31st. The pay rate for the internship is \$17.50 per hour.
