From I-35E

- ❖ Exit Oaklawn and head East (turn Left if you were on 35E-South and Right if you were on 35E-North)
- ❖ Turn Right on Cedar Spring Avenue
- ❖ Take the first left turn on Welborn Street
- ❖ Our office is in Park Creek Place, the 13-Story Building on the corner of Hall Street and Welborn Street
- ❖ The garage entrance will be to your right just after you pass the condos.
- ❖ Pull into one of the visitor parking spaces on the first level, enter the building and take the elevator up to the Penthouse. Someone will be there to greet you.

From North Central Expressway (75)

- ❖ Exit Lemmon Ave and head West
- ❖ Turn Left on Turtle Creek Blvd.
- ❖ Take the first right turn on Hall Street.
- ❖ The building will be the last one on the left.
- ❖ Our office is in Park Creek Place, the 13-Story Building on the corner of Hall Street and Welborn Street
- ❖ There is limited visitor parking in the front of the building. If there is no parking there, continue to the end of the street and turn left on Welborn.
- ❖ The garage entrance will be on your left.
- ❖ Pull into one of the visitor parking spaces on the first level, enter the building and take the elevator up to the Penthouse. Someone will be there to greet you.

From East Dallas / Rockwall

- ❖ I-30 West
- ❖ Take I-45 Exit to Houston/Sherman
- ❖ Bear Right onto I-45/US 75 North towards Sherman
- ❖ Take Exit 1A towards Hall Street / Lemmon Avenue
- ❖ Take the first left turn on Hall Street.
- ❖ Continue West on Hall Street
- ❖ Our office is in Park Creek Place, the 13-Story Building on the corner of Hall Street and Welborn Street
- ❖ There is limited visitor parking in the front of the building. If there is no parking there, continue to the end of the street and turn left on Welborn.
- ❖ The garage entrance will be on your left.
- ❖ Pull into one of the visitor parking spaces on the first level, enter the building and take the elevator up to the Penthouse. Someone will be there to greet you.
