Junior ACE (SB70)

Did you know that there are fewer U.S. students that pursue science and engineering degrees than the case of students in other countries? U.S. K-12 students are behind on knowledge and skills at the international level. With that, Sacramento ACE and the Los Rios Community College District teamed up and were awarded the SB70 grant in order to fund Junior ACE. Like ACE Sacramento, Junior ACE reaches out to the youth, but at the 6-8th grade level. We expose middle school students to ACE so that they can have a general idea of what they are interested at an early age.

We have created four modules in order to expose them to Architecture, Construction and Engineering. Last year, we were able to launch our Junior ACE Program at Golden State Middle school in Washington Unified, this year we have the potential to be apart of four different school districts and tap into 12 different middle schools.
