Thomas F. Gilbane, Jr. is the chairman and chief executive officer of Gilbane Building Company.

In 2006, Gilbane had revenues in excess of \$3 billion. Gilbane is one of the nation's largest general contractors, construction managers, and program managers providing a full slate of facilities-related services for clients in the educational, healthcare, life sciences, mission-critical, corporate, sports and recreation, criminal justice and aviation markets. Gilbane has more than 25 offices and has helped manage the construction of projects like the World War II Memorial in Washington, D.C., O'Hare Airport in Chicago, and other landmark structures across the country.

Tom joined Gilbane Building Company full-time in 1970, after having worked six summers in various training assignments. He has served in most field and office positions. He was appointed Vice President - Regional Manager in 1976 and moved to Cleveland, Ohio to open the Midwest Regional Office. In 1983, Mr. Gilbane was appointed Executive Vice President and Chief Operations Officer, and he returned to the Corporate Office in Providence in 1984. He was appointed President and Chief Operating Officer in 1997 and Chairman and Chief Executive Officer in 2004.

He is a director of Gilbane Inc., Gilbane Building Company, Gilbane Development Company, U. S. Lacrosse Foundation Board Member; member of the Brown University Engineering Advisory Committee, and a Babson College Trustee.
