As part of the ACE Mentor Program Scholarship Selection Terms, recipients must have a commitment to pursuing an education/career in the Design-Construction Industry.

The ACE Mentor Program is a not-for-profit organization that helps prepare high school students for careers in design and construction through mentoring by industry professionals. It is a partnership between high schools in Chattanooga and north Georgia, universities, architects, interior designers, engineers, construction management companies, professional organizations.

Students and their mentors from these various design/build industries meet approximately 15 times a year to work on a design project that is presented at the end of the season. The program concludes with the Awards Banquet where scholarships are presented to the selected high school seniors who plan to further their education and pursue careers in these industries.
