Online Application Instructions:

Follow the steps below to complete your Online Application (including online Parent Consent Form).

1. Go to www.acementor.org/students
2. Click on [Registration/Login](#) on the left side of the page.
3. If you are a **Returning Student**, log in with the same email address and password as last year.
4. If you are a **New Student**, click [Register as Student](#) at the bottom of the page.
5. After logging in, you will see the application for the Program Year 2018-2019.
6. Fill in your information.
*Make sure to spell your email address and your parent/guardian's email address correctly.
If you are accepted into ACE, you will be notified by email in December.*
7. Read and electronically sign the Consent Form.
8. Your parent/guardian will be sent an email request to electronically sign the Consent Form.
(Look for "ACE Mentor Program - Form Request" from the ACE Mentor Program of America.)
9. Check your email inbox and click the link to verify your email address.
(Look for "ACE Mentor Program – Account Verification" from the ACE Mentor Program of America.)
10. After your parent/guardian electronically signs the Consent Form, your Online Application will be complete.
