Terms and Conditions for Receiving and Maintaining ACE Scholarship Funding

To receive an ACE Scholarship, the following terms and conditions must be met. The recipient must attend college as a full time student. The payment of ACE scholarship funds is not automatic. Certain criteria must be met and maintained, and funds must be requested in writing with proper documentation.

Scholarship funds are paid in two installments and must be used within four years of high school graduation. Funds are awarded after the student has successfully completed a college term and submits a transcript of their grades. Scholarship recipient must provide official documentation of enrollment as a full time student and paid tuition in an approved A/C/E-related major at the college or university they attend (for first scholarship installment), and a transcript showing completed classes and minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 in an approved major (for second scholarship installment). If these criteria are not met, scholarship funds will NOT be awarded.

The following is a list of college majors that have been approved by the ACE Board for scholarship recipients. Failure to enter an approved major, or failure to maintain the major, will result in forfeiture of scholarship funds.

Approved majors are:

- Architecture
- Construction Management
- Engineering
- Apprentice program (connected to an ACE related industry)
- One- and two-year certificate programs (connected to an ACE related industry)
- Related Fields (as approved by Board)
