### **REQUESTED DOCUMENTS**

- Cover letter, which should include information on the student's career path and/or education direction
- Completed Application Form through [acementor.org](http://acementor.org)
- Transcripts of grades (cumulative and most recent quarter)
- Two letters of recommendation one from a mentor and one from a teacher

### **ESSAY QUESTIONS**

The following questions will be on the application through the [acementor.org](http://acementor.org) website. Please be prepared to answer in 300 words or less.

1. Describe the impact the design and construction industries have on our society. Why are these professions so important?
2. Which segment of the industry (architecture, engineering, construction, or related field) do you wish to enter and why? Were you planning a career in this field before starting the ACE program or did ACE help steer you in that direction? If so, how/why? Also, please tell us your top three choice for your future education (what schools)
3. Describe your experience with your ACE mentors? How will this experience help you as you transition from high school? What effect did this experience have on your college choice, or choice of study? What was the most valuable lesson you learned from your time with the ACE Mentor program?
4. Is there anything else you wish to share with the scholarship committee?
