We formed in early 2021 amid the COVID pandemic and successfully completed two sessions with local students in 2021 and 2022. We've introduced the architecture, engineering, and construction fields to dozens of local high school students, including providing internships, college scholarships, and summer camp sponsorship to several students.

As we are getting set to continue our program and McClatchy High School and look to expand the program to other schools in the near future, we are looking for local businesses to partner with us to support the program.
