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The Next Humberto Is Waiting. Will Your Company Open the Door?

Humberto joined ACE for a simple reason: he liked math. When his team at John Jay High School asked which group he wanted, someone said structural engineering had the most math. That was enough.

Then the doors started opening. That summer, Humberto earned an externship with Turner Construction and walked a data center still under construction. He learned what a general contractor actually does. He brought it all back to his ACE team senior year and helped lead the structural group. He earned a second externship—and the ACE scholarship, which helped him pay his own way through college when his family couldn't.

Today he's studying mechanical engineering at Northwestern, on a full ride. He credits ACE as one of the biggest reasons his application stood out.

That's what ACE does. Last year, 72 mentors gave countless hours to 178 students across 14 San Antonio area schools. We awarded \$58,000 in scholarships and placed 12 students in paid internships.

Each number is a student like Humberto who found a direction. And more want in than we can serve. San Antonio is building fast, and the industry needs skilled young people to build it.
