ABOUT ACE

The ACE Mentor Program of Washington is just one affiliate of the ACE Mentor Program of America. There are 75 affiliates around the country.

ACE in Washington started in 2001, with just one team with 11 students. For the last 24 years, thousands of students have met with hundreds of mentors to learn about architecture, engineering, and construction careers.

To date, just under \$1.3 million in scholarships have been awarded to seniors studying these fields in college. We anticipate awarding another \$130,000+ to this year's seniors in June.

The best part? Several ACE alumni are back in Puget Sound working for the firms that mentored them, and even now mentoring for ACE! **ACE works!**

STUDENT PROJECT

This year, 372 students from 82 area high schools completed ACE. They were mentored by 274 professionals from 92 local firms. Sixteen groups (nine in Seattle, four in Bellevue, two in Tacoma, and one fully virtual) met every other week to study every step of the building process, from the initial architectural designs to the final construction components.

This year, the ACE student design challenge was a community center. The "RFP" (Request for Proposal) outlined several aspects of the design:

- ➔ Promote physical and mental wellbeing, and a sense of community
 - ➔ Gymnasium to support basketball, volleyball, and pickleball
 - ➔ Mental health multi-purpose rooms and community rooms
 - ➔ Locker rooms with separate restrooms
 - ➔ Reception, office spaces, and childcare room
- ➔ Playground, outdoor fields (soccer, volleyball, etc.) and parking lot
- ➔ Sustainable design features & potential certifications (LEED, ILFI, etc.)
 - ➔ \$35 million budget
