- Learn various BIM, Estimating and other construction technologies

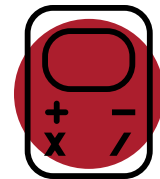

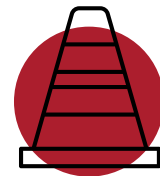
