ABOUT ACE

The ACE Mentor Program of Washington is just one affiliate of the ACE Mentor Program of America, based in Washington D.C. There are 74 affiliates all over the country.

ACE in Washington started in 2001, with just one team with 11 students.

For the last 20 years, thousands of students have met with hundreds of mentors to learn about architecture, engineering, and construction careers. To date, \$984,000 in scholarships have been awarded to seniors studying these fields in college. Our affiliate will reach \$1 million awarded **this year!**

And the best part? Several ACE alumni are back in Seattle working for the firms that mentored them, and even now mentoring for ACE! **ACE works!**

STUDENT PROJECT

For the 2021-2022 school year, 163 students from 57 area high schools completed ACE. They were mentored by 177 professionals representing 64 local firms. Ten groups (six in Seattle, two on the Eastside, one in Tacoma, and one fully virtual) met every other week to study every step of the building process, from the initial architectural designs to the final construction components.

This year, the ACE student design challenge was for a fire station on either a site in Seattle or Tacoma. The students were issued an "RFP" (Request for Proposal) which outlined several aspects of the design:

- 20,000 square feet
- Apparatus bays, parking, storage, offices, bunk rooms, kitchen, gym, and community gathering space
- LEED Gold sustainability features
- \$15 million budget

REGISTER AS AN ACE ALUMNUS

Seniors!

Before you move on to a bright post-ACE future, we need you to do two important tasks: provide ACE with a permanent email address and register as an alumnus.

Update Email Address

If you currently use a school email address, it will expire soon and we will lose contact with you! **Instructions:** Log into your existing ACE profile. (Do NOT register as NEW student!) Go to the “profile” section, and look in the top right corner for the ACTION area. From the drop-down select “edit,” and then hit the blue “Apply” button. This will allow you to update your primary email address.

Register as an ACE Alumnus

ACE alumni receive e-newsletters with opportunities for jobs, scholarships, and mentoring, as well as ACE news. **Instructions:** Log into your existing profile. (Do NOT register as NEW student!) At the top of the home page, you will see the “Alumni Request” button. Click “Register.” It’s that easy!
