

ACE Austin Alumni Scholarship Form

Scholarship form is provided for information only, students must apply via ACE Database.

The ACE Austin Alumni Scholarship will be a one-time \$2,500 scholarship awarded to a student that meets the following eligibility requirements:

- Former **ACE Austin** students who've successfully completed the program (must have attended more than half of the school year sessions).
- Enrolled and active at a four-year institution, or Community College in a major leading to a degree in one of the ACE related fields, including trade schools (listed below).
- Must be at least a third-year student (completed at least 2 full years of at an institute of higher learning/university by 2024). Both undergraduate and graduate students will be considered.
- Maintained a minimum of a 3.0 GPA in college.
- Have completed this application, provided the documents in Section III.
- Applications are due by March 1 award results will be announced in late March, with
 payout in the fall. Funds will be dispersed directly to the student. Students have two
 years to claim the award, at which time if student is not enrolled in a qualifying program,
 we reserve the right to revoke the award.
- Upon award of the ACE Austin Alumni Scholarship, you will be invited to attend an ACE session or Final Event to speak with current ACE Students.

- Proof of enrollment from your school for the applicable semester/quarter (may include proof of spring enrollment, fall enrollment will be required prior to fund disbursement).
- One (1) letter of recommendation from a college or university professor/teacher's assistant.
- Attach a 300-500 word essay describing how ACE Austin helped prepare you for college and how you plan on using your degree in AEC industries.
- Attach a 300-500 word essay explaining how a project or class was impactful to your studies or how a project/class was a major challenge for you. What were key lessons you learned about yourself or others through that project/class?
- Optional Essay: One of the previous essays listed above may be substituted with a 300-500 word essay describing the applicant's involvement in extracurricular activities and/or prior industry experiences (internships, associations, volunteer, etc.)
