ABOUT ACE

The ACE Mentor Program of Washington is just one affiliate of the ACE Mentor Program of America. There are 77 affiliates all over the country.

ACE in Washington started in 2001, with just one team with 11 students. For the last 21 years, thousands of students have met with hundreds of mentors to learn about architecture, engineering, and construction careers. To date, \$1,121,000 in scholarships have been awarded to seniors studying these fields in college. We anticipate awarding another \$100,000+ to this year's seniors in June.

The best part? Several ACE alumni are back in Puget Sound working for the firms that mentored them, and even now mentoring for ACE! **ACE works!**

STUDENT PROJECT

For the 2022-2023 school year, 255 students from 60 area high schools completed ACE. They were mentored by 220 professionals representing *a record* 80 local firms. Twelve groups (seven in Seattle, three in Bellevue, and two in Tacoma) met every other week to study every step of the building process, from the initial architectural designs to the final construction components.

This year, the ACE student design challenge was for an educational aquatic center on either a site in Seattle, Kirkland, or Tacoma. The "RFP" (Request for Proposal) outlined several aspects of the design:

- → 15,000 square feet
- → Visitors' center with interactive aquatic tanks, classrooms, offices, community room/auditorium & outdoor point-of-interest spaces
- → Sustainable design features & potential certifications (LEED, ILFI, etc.)
 → \$25 million budget

SENIORS!


Before you move on to a bright post-ACE future, we need you to do two important tasks: provide ACE with a permanent email address and register as an alumnus.

Go to the "profile" section, and look in the top right corner for the ACTION area. From the drop-down select "edit," change your email, and then hit the blue "Apply" button. This will allow you to update your primary email.
