ACE Mentor Founders Hall of Honors – Selection Criteria

The **ACE Mentor Hall of Honors** recognizes individuals whose contributions have played a significant role in shaping the success, growth, and overall impact of the ACE Mentor Program. These honorees embody the mission of ACE and have left a legacy through their leadership, commitment, and influence.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. **Historic Impact** – The nominee must have made a profound and lasting contribution to the ACE Mentor Program at the national or affiliate level. Their work should have helped shape ACE’s trajectory, sustainability, and/or expansion.
2. **Mission-Driven Leadership** – The nominee must have demonstrated a deep commitment to ACE’s mission of inspiring high school students to pursue careers in architecture, construction, and engineering.
3. **Long-Term Influence** – The nominee’s contributions should have led to measurable improvements in ACE’s programs, operations, partnerships, or reach.
4. **Time Requirement** – The nominee must have been affiliated with ACE in an active role (as a mentor, board member, staff member, or key volunteer) for at least **five years** before being considered.

Selection Process:

- **Nomination Period** – Nominations will be accepted annually, leading up to the Fall Board Meeting.
- **Review Committee** – A selection committee composed of board members and past ACE leaders will review nominations.
- **Final Decision** – Inductees will be announced at a formal recognition event during the Fall Board Meeting.

ACE Founders Hall of Honors – Nomination Process

1. Nomination Launch

- Nominations open annually on August 1.
- A call for nominations will be distributed to affiliate leaders, board members, staff, and national partners.

2. Submission Requirements

Each nomination must include:

- Nominee's name, title, and affiliate/ACE experience with dates
- Nominator's name and contact info, if applicable.
- A brief statement (500 words max) explaining:
 - The nominee's contributions to ACE
 - Alignment with the Hall of Honors eligibility criteria
- Optional: Letters of support or notable achievements (e.g., media coverage, awards, or testimonials)

3. How to Submit

- Nominations must be submitted via email to info@acementor.org with the subject line: "Hall of Honors Nomination" by September 1.

4. Review & Selection

- The Selection Committee will evaluate all submissions based on the stated criteria:
 - Historic Impact
 - Mission-Driven Leadership
 - Long-Term Influence
 - Length of Service
